

#### The Sacking of Winchester Twice



#### By Dr Tom Watson

During the Barons' War of 1216-17, Winchester was twice captured and occupied by French troops led by Prince Louis of France. In this talk, Tom Watson tells the story of why the barons invited the French to invade and how Winchester and the central South was affected. ## The French in Romsey 1792-1805 Forgotten Stories



#### An Illustrated talk by Janet Cairney




